Meet the meerkats

Visit "Meerkat Mountain" the home of our family group of these inquisitive and mischievous animals. They eat a wide variety of foods so prepare yourself for giving them live insects, meat, eggs or a healthy salad!

Also hear about the work that Shaldon Wildlife Trust supports in Vietnam helping to save some of the world's most endangered small carnivores. Bring a camera as these guys never fail to show off for a photo shoot!

Lemur liaison

Come and meet our group of Ring-tailed lemurs. Ricky and the girls are always pleased to meet new people, especially if you give them a treat!

You will have the chance to give them their feed and learn about the conservation efforts in Madagascar that Shaldon Wildlife Trust are proud to support. Bring your camera, this is a fantastic chance to get a great snap of these amazing creatures who are always willing to strike a pose!

2 people, 15-20 mins. Min age 8 yrs with an accompanying adult.

Keeper for the day

£75

A fantastic, access all areas experience with our keeper team. Spend the day up close and personal with some of our amazing animals. Starting off with the morning feeds, you will get the chance interact with some of the animals as you take them their breakfast. After lunch, you will get down and dirty – cleaning out some of the animal enclosures and giving them their enrichment. Round off your day helping prepare the afternoon feeds for the carnivores and helping out in the nocturnal house.

10am -3:30pm, 1 person: Includes a certificate and a photo of your favourite animal.

Junior keeper for the day

£55

For those aged 8-15 with an accompanying adult – you get to have a day with a difference, helping keepers in their daily tasks!

Starting in the morning with the feeding of some of our leaping Lemurs and mischievous Meerkats, you will then get to meet the reptiles in our education room before their lunch. After lunch you will be helping with the enrichment for our mini monkeys... bugs and grubs are their favourite so get ready to squirm!

All Junior keepers will get a certificate and a cuddly toy.
